1. GST Council extends levy of compensation cess till March 2026 to repay the loans

The GST Council has agreed to levy compensation cess for an extended period upto March 2026 to enable the Centre to repay the loans, including principal and interest taken, to compensate states for GST collection shortfall.

2. World Bank to stop 'ease of doing business' report as probe finds 'data juggling'

The World Bank Thursday said it would discontinue the practice of issuing Doing Business report following an investigation prompted by internal reports of "data irregularities" in its 2018 and 2020 editions (released in 2017 and 2019, respectively) and possible "ethical matters" involving bank staff.

3. Govt bails out telcos with 4-year gap in spectrum, AGR payouts

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday cleared a reform-oriented bailout package for the beleaguered telecom industry - freeing up cash for the financially stretched companies by throwing in a four-year moratorium on spectrum and AGR payments, while also slashing charges and offering a lenient definition of revenue recognition to hasten the transition towards 5G.

4. Production-linked incentive Scheme: Rs 26,000-crore PLI for clean tech auto investments

The Cabinet on Wednesday cleared a Rs 25,938-crore production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme to promote advanced technological products in the auto and auto components sector. Under this, the government will offer up to 18% incentive to eligible investors over a five-year period.
